Presentation by Hunden Strategic Partners (via conference call) re: Mixed Use Development Feasibility Study for I-74 property Hunden Strategic Partners (HSP) is a real estate development company that was hired to do a market analysis for commercial uses of the city's 174 property. It was determined that "the commercial market in Farmer City is challenged but stable". HSP's recommendation is for Farmer City to acquire a gas station, fast food restaurant, casual dining restaurant and a mid-scale hotel for the location and to postpone multi-family residential development for when conditions improve. She will update social media with this information. In addition, the pool received its permit and still has a projected opening of June 1<sup>st</sup>.
